Main Street, Springerville, AZ 85938 until 4:30 pm, local time, May 28, 2009, and there, at said office, at said time, publicly opened and read aloud.

This project includes the rehabilitation of Runway 3-21 which involves approximately 18,000 linear feet of asphalt pavement repairs, crack sealing, and some pavement markings. This project also includes improvement of the Runway 21 end safety area to meet FAA design standards, which includes grading and restoration and fence installation.
